



UCAT Course 2020-2021

What is the UCAT and do I need to sit it?

The University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT) is an admissions test used by the UCAT ANZ Consortium of universities in Australia and New Zealand for their medical, dental and clinical science degree programmes.

The test helps universities to select applicants with the most appropriate abilities and professional behaviours required for new doctors and dentists to be successful in their clinical careers. It is used in collaboration with other admissions processes such as interviews and academic qualifications.

It is also an opportunity to stand out from other applicants and demonstrate aptitude for a demanding programme of study.

Please note that some pathways to medicine/dentistry/clinical sciences will not require the UCAT, and a different test may be required. For details, candidates should refer to the websites of the universities to which they intend to apply.

The sections of the UCAT are:

1. **Verbal Reasoning:** Assesses the ability to critically evaluate information presented in a written form.
2. **Decision Making:** Assesses the ability to make sound decisions and judgements using complex information.
3. **Quantitative Reasoning:** Assesses the ability to critically evaluate information presented in a numerical form.
4. **Abstract Reasoning:** Assesses the use of convergent and divergent thinking to infer relationships from information.
5. **Situational Judgement:** Measures the capacity to understand real world situations and to identify critical factors and appropriate behaviour in dealing with them.

What is the UCAT course structure offered at MedPrep?

What are the other requirements and points to consider?

1. Attendance: It is compulsory for students to attend all scheduled lessons as these lessons follow a set structure.
2. Learning Materials: All the learning and homework material is included for **FREE** for all the enrolled students.
3. MedPrep Enrolment & Cancellation Policy:
 - a. **Enrolment**
 1. The minimum enrolment period is for five consecutive sessions from the agreed date of enrolment. There are strictly no cancellations allowed within this period.
 - b. **Withdrawal**
 1. After fulfilling the five consecutive sessions as indicated above, two weeks' notice in writing to info@medprepofficial.com.au is required for any cancellation of enrolment. A fee corresponding to two weeks of sessions will be deducted should MedPrep not be informed of a student's cancellation.
 - c. **Absences**
 1. If a student is unable to attend their regular class, a replacement class should be requested by emailing info@medprepofficial.com.au **at least one week prior** to their scheduled class.
 2. MedPrep will make all attempts to accommodate a replacement session to make up for the missed session, however we cannot guarantee this option if there is not an available replacement class at the time of the absence or if insufficient notice was given.
 3. MedPrep will provide a copy of all class materials from any missed lessons for parents or students who email to inform of the student's absence.
 4. There will be no credit/refund for any missed lessons, except for when more than two consecutive classes will be missed.
 5. If you intend to miss more than two weeks of classes during the term period, please email info@medprepofficial.com.au **at least four weeks before the intended absence** to receive your credit or refund.
 - d. **Payment**
 1. Payments must be made in advance before commencing classes.
 2. Students who commence classes later than the class starting date will have to pay the fees only for the remaining sessions.
 3. If fees for a student who has attended classes are unpaid for more than 14 days after the invoice date, an administration charge of \$30 per week will accrue on the account and the student may be denied entry to the sessions until the invoice is paid, unless alternative arrangements are made.
 - e. **Amendment**
 1. MedPrep reserves the right to amend or discontinue any or all parts of this policy at any time.
